

Cohort Completion at Maximum Time, Analyses at Close of AY 2014-15

Summary

Doctoral programs allow seven years for the maximum time to completion. Only the PsyD at Chicago had a cohort that elapsed its seventh year during 2014-15. Only three students from the cohort of seventy-six were still attending past seven years. All three dual-enrolled in a master-level degree program and received either approved leaves of absence or approved extensions to complete capstone requirements.

Master programs allow five years for the maximum time to completion. The MA cohort that elapsed its fifth year during 2014-15 had two hundred eighty-four students, from ten programs at Chicago and two programs at Vancouver. Only five of those students were still attending past five years. All five received extensions to complete capstone requirements, or had leaves of absence, or often attended part-time.

Doctor Degrees

Anticipated time to completion with full-time enrollment: five years.

Maximum time allowed toward completion: seven years.
