*Note.* The Fall 2015 entering cohort is the first to graduate after the MCFT program received COAMFTE-accreditation. Regarding licensure in the state of Illinois, Associate Marriage and Family Therapists were not eligible to sit for the AMFTRB licensing exam until they had completed their clinical hours for licensure which is no sooner than two years after their degree has been conferred. This restriction was updated in June 2018 and now graduates are eligible once they have their ALMFT. Data provided for job placement rate and in PhD programs is of those graduates who graduated and data for the national exam pass rate is of those graduates who have sat for the exam.
