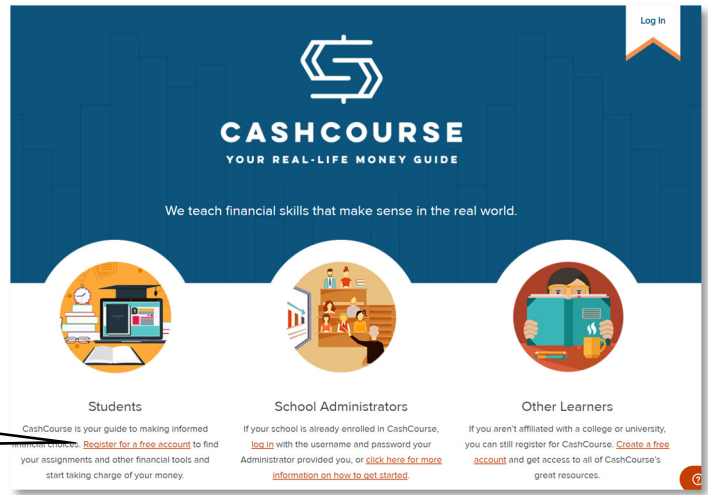
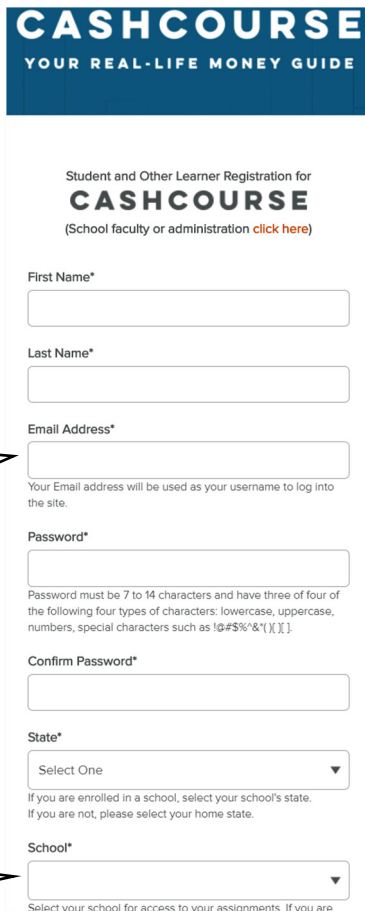


Register for CashCourse.org

This free resource provides tools for students to develop strong money-management skills that can help with both personal and educational finances.

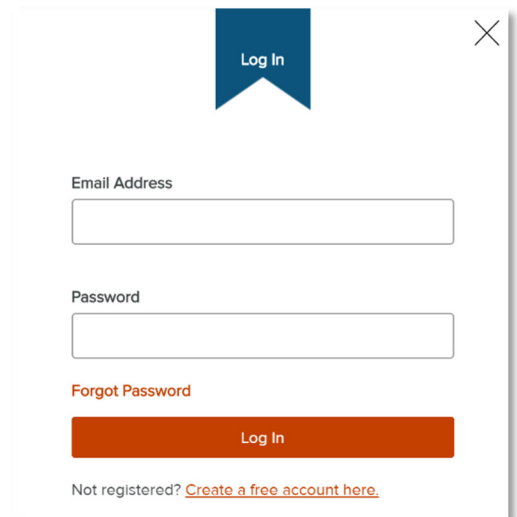
To create an account, under the “Students” section click on “Register for a free account” link.

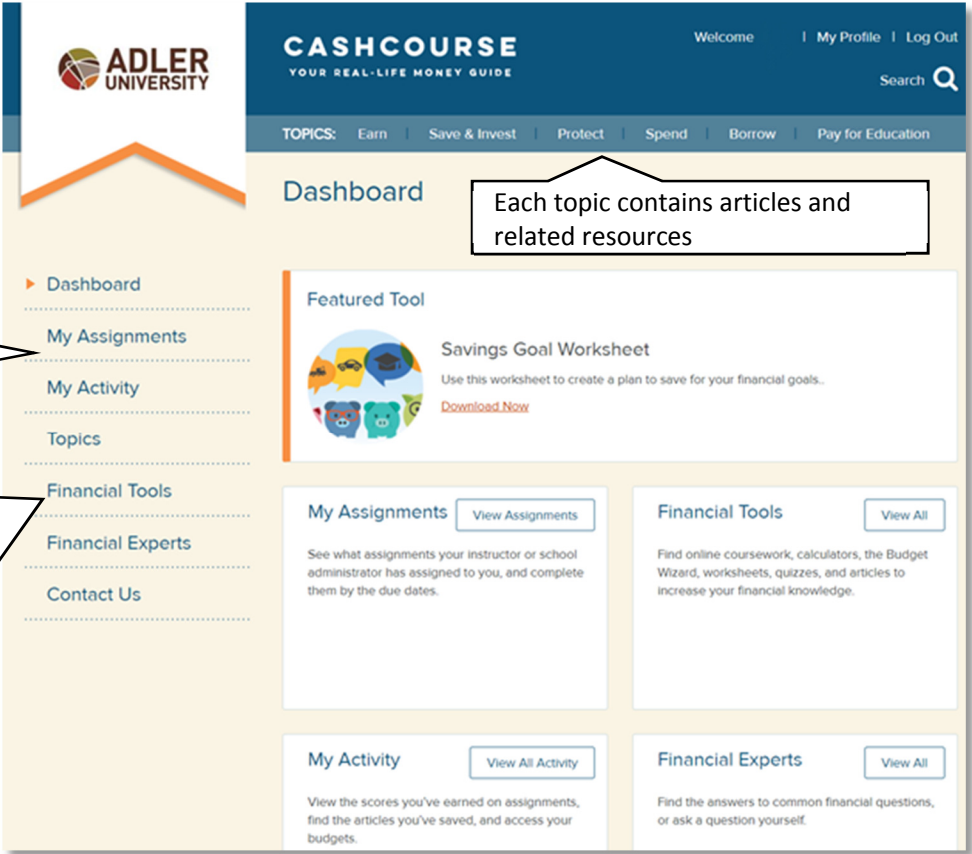
Under “School” select Adler University.

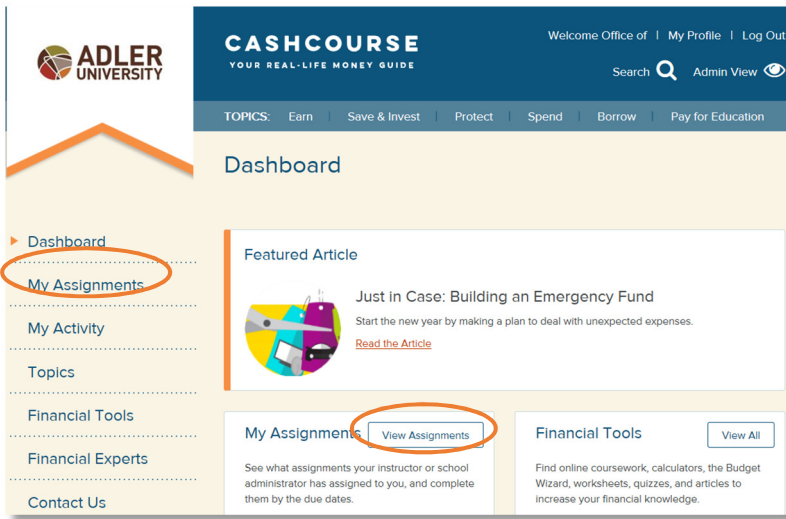

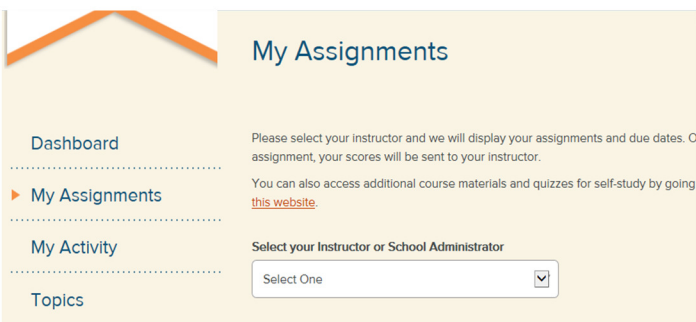

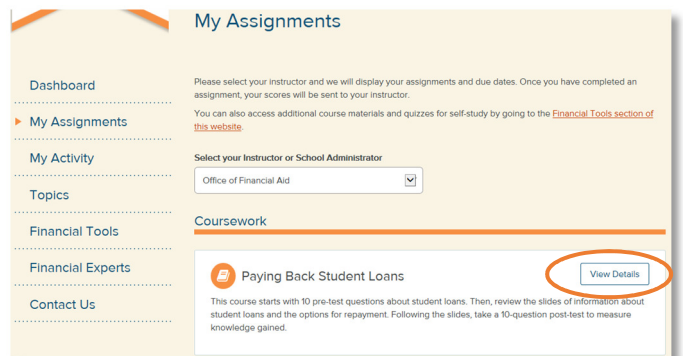
Accessing and Completing Assignments

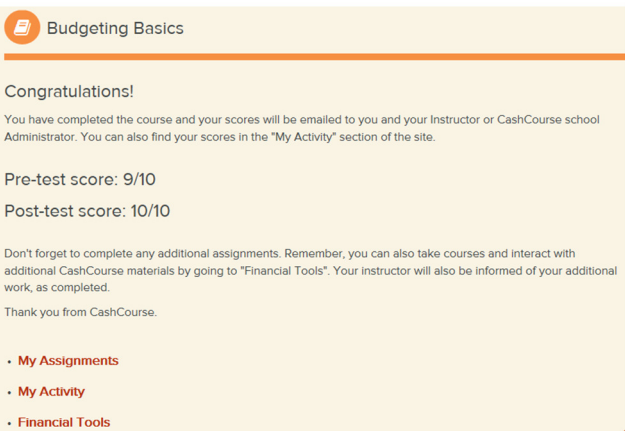


Under “Select your Instructor or School Administrator” select “Office of Financial Aid”.

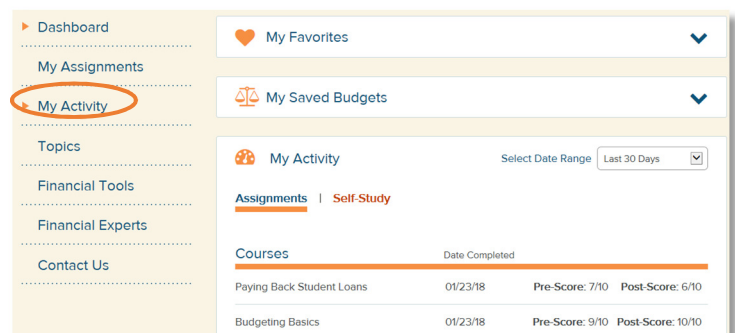


To fulfill the debt-management activity requirement, complete all 3 courses listed under the “Coursework” section, select “View Details” and then “Begin Course”.

This page also contains recommended quizzes and worksheets that can enhance positive budgeting skills.



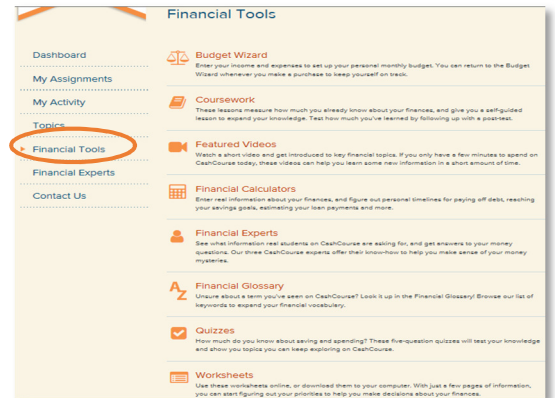
After the completion of each assignment, you will see your final score and you will receive an email confirming the completion of the assignment.



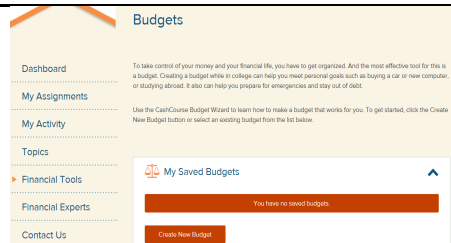
Click on “My Activity” to view assignments you have completed. To view unassigned activities you have completed click on “Self-Study”.

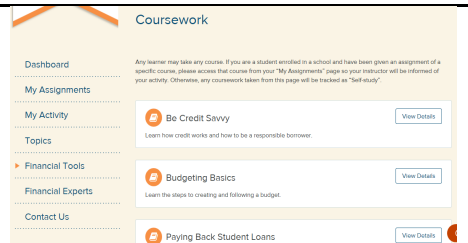

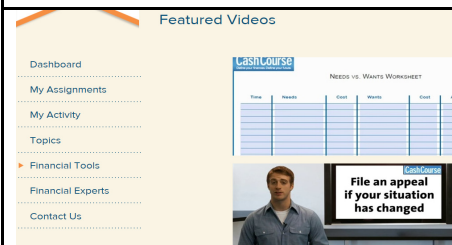
Financial Tools at a Glance



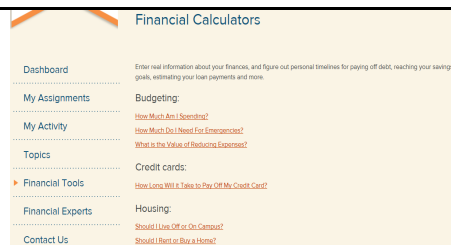
Budget Wizard – Select “Create New Budget” to enter your expenses to create a monthly budget and learn valuable information about budgeting.



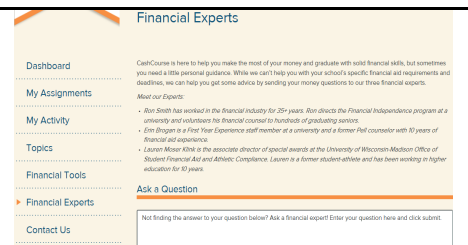
Coursework – This section includes all assigned and unassigned self-paced coursework on a variety of topics.



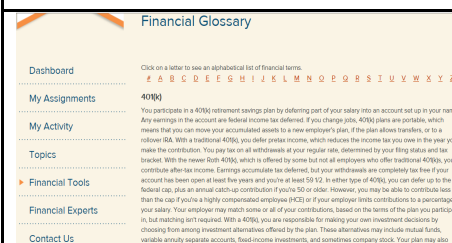
Featured Videos – View videos about paying back student loans, budgeting and saving, finding extra money and how to be credit savvy.



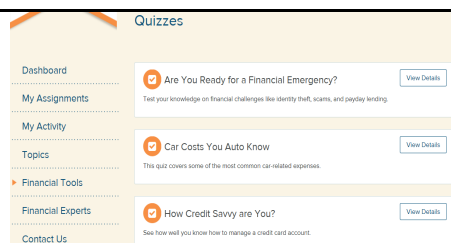
Financial Calculators– This feature will assist you in planning how to pay off your debt, reaching savings goal, estimate loan payments and more.



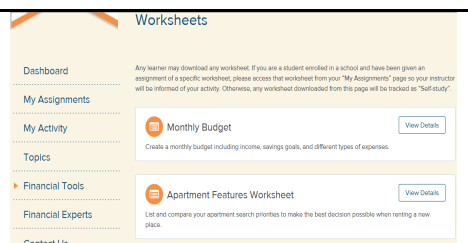
Financial Experts – Post finance related questions, receive an answer from a financial professional and view previous Q & A's postings.
