



GUIDE FOR 14 DAYS QUARANTINE

Self-Isolation on Return to B.C.

Last Updated: April 24, 2020

- Unless you <u>are exempt</u>, all international travellers returning to B.C. are required by law to self-isolate for 14 days and complete a self-isolation plan
- Travellers must <u>submit a B.C. self-isolation plan</u> and <u>complete the federal ArriveCAN</u>
 <u>application</u> for approval prior to their return to B.C., or upon arrival

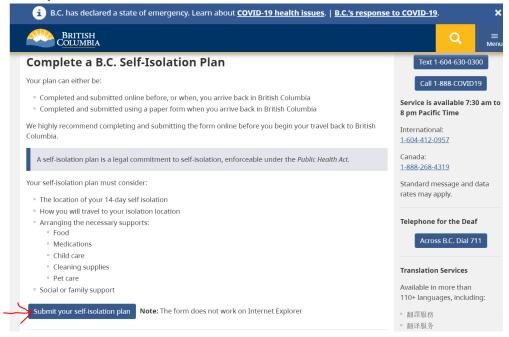
