One-Year Persistence, Fall 2019 - Fall 2020

Adler University defines 'Persistence' as the ratio of students who have not withdrawn from the university over a specified period of time. 'Persisted' students include those who are still engaged with the University in a student capacity with *Colleague* status 'Active' and are either actively enrolled, on Leave of Absense, active but not registered, or pending graduation. 'Persistence' is synonymous to 'Retention' in that the students persisted, and the University retained those students. 'Withdrawn' students includes all students with *Colleague* status 'Withdrawn', the reasons for which may be voluntary or administrative.

Although all programs are online in the fall 2020 term due to COVID-19, 'Online' programs in this report include programs typically offered in a fully online modality.

One-Year Persistence rates review the status of students who were actively enrolled one year prior to the present term and presents the ratio of those students who have "Persisted" versus "Withdrawn". Hence, the Fall 2020 One-Year Persistence report reviews the Fall 2020 status of students who were active in Fall 2019. These rates are presented in aggregate for the University, and separately by campus, demographics, and program.
