

## Completion Rates at Close of AY2022-23

Adler University defines 'Completion' in terms of the maximum time allowed for students in each program level (masters, doctoral) to satisfactorily complete all degree requirements. The 'Completion Rate' is the ratio of students who have satisfactorily completed all degree requirements within the maximum time allowed by their program. At the close of the 2022-23 academic year this included students who began a doctoral program in the 2016-17 academic year or a masters program in the 2018-19 academic year and did not have a Leave of Absence on their record extending their maximum time to completion.

Note that this report has been adjusted to include all students with a start date within a given academic year rather than only including those students who began in the fall term.

Doctoral programs allow seven years from the date of first registration following admission to the program for students to satisfactorily complete all degree requirements.

Masters programs allow five years from the date of first registration following admission to the program for students to satisfactorily complete all degree requirements.
