One-Year Persistence, Fall 2022 - Fall 2023

Adler University defines 'Persistence' as the ratio of students who have not withdrawn from the university over a specified period of time. 'Persisted' students include those who are still engaged with the University in a student capacity with *Colleague* status 'Active' and are either actively enrolled, on Leave of Absence, active but not registered, or pending graduation. 'Persistence' is synonymous to 'Retention' in that the students persisted, and the University retained those students. 'Withdrawn' students includes all students with a status of 'Withdrawn', the reasons for which may be voluntary or administrative.

One-Year Persistence rates review the status of students who were actively enrolled one year prior to the present term and presents the ratio of those students who have "Persisted" versus "Withdrawn". Hence, the Fall 2023 One-Year Persistence report reviews the Fall 2023 status of students who were active in Fall 2022.
