


Figure 1: 2023 Advocacy Landscape Map from the American Art Therapy Association

Students must obtain the ATR credential, along with a state issued license (such as LPCC), to practice mental health care legally in California. To obtain a ATR credential, students must complete the required educational prerequisities to gain the ATR-P credential, gain ay least 1,000 post education clinical exeprience in art therapy, and apply for the ATR credential, and pass the ATCB exam after meeting all requirements. Students in California seeking an LPCC to practice art therapy must obtain a master's or doctoral degree in art therapy, register as a Associate Professional Clinical Counselor (APCC), complete 3,000 hours of clinical supervised experience, pass the California Law and Ethics exam and the National Clinical Mental Health Counselor Exam.
